



OPPORTUNITIES & GROWTH

1 in every 12

people (age 6+) in the Florida Section played tennis in 2021, up slightly from the proportion in 2020 (1 in 13). By comparison, approximately 1 in every 14 Americans played tennis in 2021.

Total U.S. Tennis Players in 2021

22.54M

Number of Americans, ages 6 and older, who played tennis at least once in 2021, representing 7.4% of the population

Core Tennis Players in 2021



Trends in Participation Rates

The percentage of people age 6+ in the Florida Section who played tennis at least once in the past 12 months increased markedly from where it stood in 2020 and remains significantly ahead of the Section's pre-pandemic levels. Meanwhile, the overall tennis participation rate in the U.S. increased slightly year-over-year, from 7.1% in 2020 to 7.4% in 2021.




