


- Statewide. regional. national. international. collegiate. youth. amateur. Olympic trials. elite training




How did we get here?

Niche Sports – Venue Development

- Investment in facilities which cater to less popular or "niche" sports
- Focus on attributes that elevate the competition experience for athletes
- Consult with experts in the sport, ask for "wish list"
- Consider international designation requirements


