

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act

The McKinney-Vento Act's Education for Homeless Children and Youth (EHCY) program was originally enacted in 1987 and reauthorized in 2015 by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

Main themes:

- School access & stability- "One Child, One School, One Year"
- Delineates homeless students' rights equitable and quality
- Support for academic success coordinated with Title I, Part A
- Establishes a multilevel infrastructure to support homeless students

The MVA Homeless Definitions

The McKinney-Vento Act defines "homeless" as those individuals who:

- Lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence
- Share the housing of others due to financial hardship
- Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, camping grounds or substandard housing
- Living in emergency or transitional shelters
- Living in a public or private place not designed for humans to live
- Living in cars, **parks**, abandoned buildings, bus or train stations, etc.
- Abandoned in hospitals
- Migratory children living in above circumstances

Homeless Unaccompanied Youth

Youth who meet the definition of homeless and are not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian





HEAT Services

HEAT provides assistance with:

- School selection school of origin
- Immediate enrollment
- Verifies MVA status for transportation to
- the school of origin
- LIMITED temporary transportation (bus passes/gas card)
- Free meal benefits
- School supplies
- Limited help with gift cards, school supplies and backpacks
- Professional Development
- Presentations and representation at HLA/CoC
- Informing parents of their MVA rights

- Clothes-2-Kids










HEAT does NOT provide:

- Case Management
- Housing or rental funding
- Utility funding
- Bus pass/gas card if ineligible for PCS transportation

Shelter or transitional housing


Hotel or motel
