- Senate

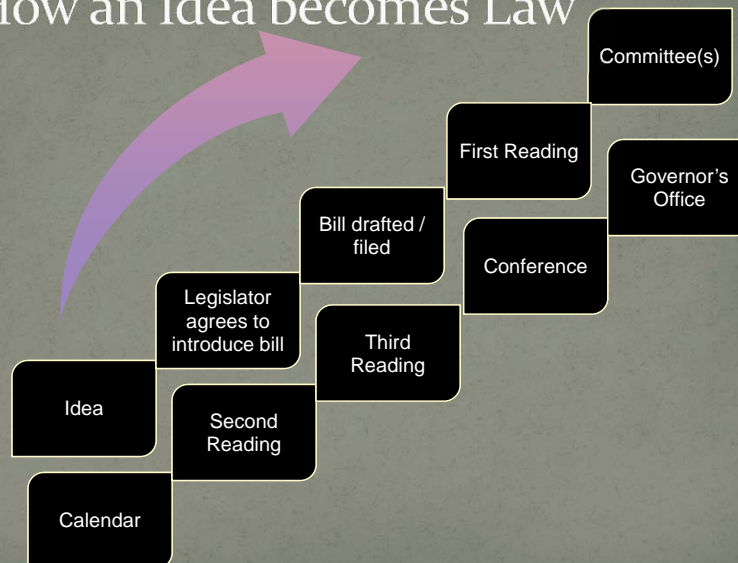
